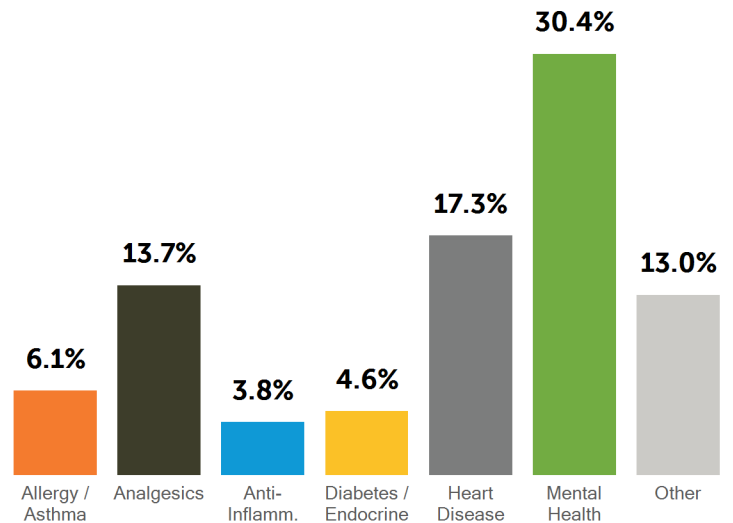

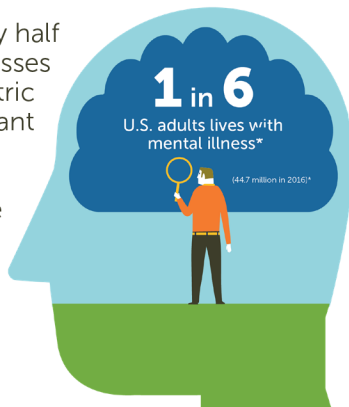


Impact Locally on Mental Health
