
OUR INITIATIVES



211 is a free, comprehensive information and referral system linking Iowa residents to health and human service programs, community services, disaster services and governmental programs. 211 is a one-stop source of information for people looking for local services.



FamilyWize provides free, reusable prescription drug discount cards for people with no or low prescription drug coverage.



Sprout Into Reading targets low-income youth ages birth to five years of age, offering books to youth who many not otherwise have access to them at home. A key focus of the program is to provide direct distribution of books to these children through strategic partnerships.
