

2022 Grant Questions

Week of January 10th – 14th 2022

Q: Does this funding cover operating costs?

A: Yes, grant funds can be used for operating costs including staff.

Q: Are the required quarterly funded partner meetings virtual?

A: Yes, the funded partner meetings are held via zoom until further notice.

Q: What percentage of indirect costs is allowed?

A: We do not have a specific percentage. Use what is typical and reasonable for your agency.

Q: Under the outcomes section, we must choose what is listed, correct? There is not a place to list our own?

A: Correct. Applicants must choose a minimum of 3 outcomes to report on. There is no requirement to write in your own outcome.

Q: Can you send out the PowerPoint used for the Community Information Sessions?

A: The PowerPoint will be posted to our website on Friday February 14th.

Q: Can grant funds cover physical plant renovations?

A: If you are able to tie your need to an outcome as well as be able to report on that outcome for the two year grant, it may be possible.

Q: Is the budget for one year or the entire 2 year grant?

A: One year.

Q: Can we change what we have written for in the past?

A: Yes, as long as it ties to the outcomes it can be a new program or a continuation of an existing program.

Q: Can you talk more about the shift to poverty prevention/reduction?

A: UWDATS spent the last year reviewing data and working on a strategic plan to continue to refine our work to make the biggest positive impact on the community. Our pillars of Health, Education, and Financial Stability/Income are so closely tied to poverty that it was not a stretch to place an emphasis on this work. Having our focus on poverty prevention/reduction, we will be able to see the collective impact from our funded partners through the streamlined reporting process and more easily adjust to meet the community needs.
