"Hawkeye Area Community Action Program helped me when I couldn't pay my bills. Friends of the Family assisted us with other housing issues," said Nicole.

But her struggles continued. After more than a decade of ups and downs, Nicole found herself and her three children on the verge of homelessness. Through her caseworker, Nicole learned to set goals, balance a budget and create a better life for her family.
